The **Democracy International Fund** is an all-world ex-US large & mid cap international equity portfolio that leverages *The Economist* Magazine's Democracy Index to **systematically tilt** the portfolio **toward democracies** and **away from authoritarians**.

The Fund seeks to track the total return performance, before fees and expenses, of the Democracy Investments International Index.

Authoritarianism Creates Risk

- Higher growth volatility
- More frequent short-term crises
- Rules can change
- Government & judicial corruption
- Governments control private sector (SOEs)
- War, revolution, and civil unrest

Democracies Foster Economic Growth

- Lower growth volatility
- Better at avoiding economic crises
- Rule of law & property rights
- Efficient & transparent use of capital
- Observe faster technological change, a primary driver of longterm growth
- Higher per-capita GDP



Problem

The MSCI and FTSE all world ex-US indices use market-cap based methodologies which generally only account for company size and ignore country risk attributes:

- Geopolitical and currency risk
- Shareholder protections and rule of law
- Corruption, favoritism, lack of civil liberties or checks and balances

Solution

The Democracy Investments International Index incorporates *The Economist's*Democracy Index country scores with a systematic tilting strategy:

- Over weights countries that embrace democracy
- Under weights more authoritarian countries
- Accounts for trends in de-globalization and shifting supply chains


Methodology of The Economist's Democracy Index



The Economist Intelligence Unit's index of democracy, on a 0 to 10 scale, is based on the ratings for **60 indicators**, grouped into five categories:

- 1. Electoral process and pluralism
- 2. Civil liberties
- 3. The functioning of government.
- 4. Political participation
- 5 Political culture



% Weight in Indices by Country



March 31, 2021 - September 30, 2024







Democracy Investments has entered into an agreement with The Economist Group to license their "Democracy Index" for five years. The Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU), the research and analysis division of Economist Group, provides forecasting and advisory services through research and analysis and is responsible for the Democracy Index. The EIU's Democracy Index provides a snapshot of the state of world democracy for 165 independent states and two territories. The Democracy Index is based on five categories: electoral process and pluralism; civil liberties; the functioning of government; political participation; and political culture. Each category has a rating on a 0 to 10 scale, and the overall index is the simple average of the five category indexes. Full democracies have scores greater than 8; authoritarian regimes have scores less than or equal to 4.

It is not possible to invest directly into an index. Democracy Investments selects securities based on applying its proprietary methodology which incorporates the Democracy Index.
